Fall Deer & Turkey Archery Hunting Permits Requirements and Rules

New for 2026 due to overwhelming interest, we are striving to give all members a chance to participate. Our Fall Deer and Turkey Archery Hunting Permits will be available to all members on a lottery style bases at no cost for the permit. Any previously issued permits are no longer valid. We are separating the fall archery season into two parts. Both parts will include permission to hunt both Deer and Wild Turkey. There will be only five (5) permits issued for each part season for a total of ten (10) permits issued for the year.

(Season Part A) – Will run from September 15 through November 7

(Season Part B) – Will run from November 8, through December 31

Requirements to participate:

Archery Deer Hunting – Requires a valid Connecticut resident/non-resident Archery Deer/Small Game Hunting License. You must follow all state and PFG rules and regulations. Including State mandated daily and season bag limits, and harvest tagging.

Archery Turkey Hunting – Requires a valid Connecticut resident/non-resident Archery Deer/Small Game Hunting License & a Resident Game Bird Conservation Stamp. You must follow all state and PFG rules and regulations. Including State mandated daily and season bag limits, and harvest tagging.

If you have a preference for either season Part – A, or Part – B, please indicate that preference when applying for a permit. If you are selected from the lottery for a permit you will be required to provide your hunting licensing for review.

Rules:

CT DEEP blaze orange clothing requirements shall be followed at all times.

Rules, Continued:

You must maintain a safe distance from the driveway, clubhouse, and outdoor ranges as they will not be shut down for the fall Deer and Turkey Hunting Season.

At all times, be aware of your target and what's beyond to avoid any accidents or unnecessary damages.

We have several members who routinely walk their dogs on PFG property. These members are advised to use extreme caution during the fall Deer & Turkey hunting season.

All tree stands left up year round are considered fair game for other hunters to use.

Harassment of hunters will not be tolerated.

PFG permits along with your hunting licenses must be carried on your person at all times while hunting. If you are approached by an Executive Board Member, an RSO, or the range chairman, you must show your permit and hunting license if requested.

Anyone in violation of PFG or State of Connecticut DEEP rules and regulations will have his/her hunting and membership privileges immediately suspended, and may be reinstated pending a review by the Executive Committee.

If you are successful in harvesting an animal your permit will be retired for the year to allow another hunter opportunity.
